The Point Reyes National Seashore has some of the best, well groomed, and most varied trails in Northern California. You can ride through sunny cattle pastures, through conifer forests and rainforest-like areas. If your horse (or mule) is used to all-day rides through the mountains, you can ride to the beach. The trail to Olema winds through beautiful redwoods and alongside marshes, and crosses cattle grazing land. Also, you can trailer to Limentour Beach, where you can ride on the sand and play with your horse in the waves.

At the Five Brooks Horse Camp (formally Stewart Ranch), you will find -

- Bathrooms with flush toilets, sinks and hot showers no coins required.
- Pole ties are available (but limited) around the perimeter of the campground. If you do not want to use a pole tie, plan on tying to your trailer, to a Hi Tie or bring a portable corral.
- Water: There are several faucets for horse water. Bring hoses and hose splitters
- Access to several beautifully groomed trails from the campground.
- Dogs are not permitted at the Five Brooks Campground

Delicious Food will be provided by Mike, Fixin's Elegant Country Cuisine. This means you bring no cooking equipment and you have no dishes to do either!! Meals begin on May 9<sup>th</sup> with dinner and end with lunch on May 13. The participation/catering and camping fee is \$400. We require your full payment with your registration to hold your "spot".

You do not have to make your own campsite reservation. We made the reservations for our group.

For the first time, WANAC has reserved the entire campground!!

If you are planning on coming in before May 9, you will need to make your own camp registration with Five Brooks, for the days not included in our group reservation. Their number is 415-663-1570.
